EUCALYPTUS OIL

NB: Eucalyptus Oil is a poison and is flammable – keep away from children and sources of ignition.

PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

Eucalyptus oil removes many adhesives, sticky labels, chewing gum, wax, stubborn stains and grease marks. It is excellent as an additive to laundry washes – it cleans and freshens and helps to kill dust mites and remove allergens. A few drops on a handkerchief helps relieve the symptoms of colds and flu, and applying Eucalyptus Oil to insect bites helps relieve pain and itchiness.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE AS A LAUNDRY ADDITIVE:

For **hot water washes** (over 55°C), use normal laundry detergent plus 10 mls Eucalyptus Oil to kill dust mites and remove allergens.

For **washes under 55°C**, fill washing machine with warm water to the desired level. Mix Eucalyptus Oil with Dishwashing liquid in the ratio of 3 parts Eucalyptus Oil to 1 part Dishwashing Liquid (75% Eucalyptus Oil to 25% Dishwashing Liquid). Add this mixture to washing at the following rate:

Water Capacity (Litres)	25	50	100
Add Mixture (mls)	68	135	270

(A standard double blanket is usually washed in approximately 50 Litres water so you would need to add 135 mls of the mixture of Eucalyptus Oil and Dishwashing Liquid.)

Note: 5mls = 1 teaspoon

Mix briefly and then leave to soak for 30 minutes. Doubling dose strength or soaking time increases the percentage of mites which are killed.

STORAGE

Store EUCALYPTUS OIL sealed in a cool dry area.

SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

Do not mix chemicals and always add chemicals to water.
