# BARMATE

### PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

BARMATE is strongly alkaline and cleans and sanitises beerlines and glassware, leaving them sparkling and spot-free. It controls algae which cause sour-tasting beer and leaves no detergent residue which might taint beverages.

### APPLICATIONS

BARMATE is used to clean beerlines and beer glasses in the hospitality trade.

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

#### BEERLINES

Blow pipes out, flush with water and fill lines with a 1 : 50 solution of Barmate in warm water. Allow to soak for 30 minutes, drain and flush with potable water.

#### GLASS WASHING

Mix a solution of 1 : 50 Barmate in water and add to detergent reservoir of machine.

#### GLASS DESCALING

Descale glasses with a solution of 1:20 Barmate in water.

### DILUTION RATES

Beerlines	1 Part Barmate to 50 Parts warm water.
Glass washers	1 Part Barmate to 50 Parts water
Descale glass	1 Part Barmate to 20 parts water

### SAFETY PRECAUTION

Strong caustic solutions can cause burns. Read and follow all information in the Material Safety Data Sheet.

### STORAGE

Bar-mate contains chlorine and has a shelf life of approximately 6 months. Store in a cool dark place. Always replace lid immediately after use. **Keep away from children.**
